The school plans to organise a one-day tour for S2 students during the Student Development Day to give them an opportunity to learn about the culture of Hong Kong's walled villages as well as the traditional life of the New Territories. Details of the trip are as follows :

Date : Thursday 21 November, 2019
Time : 8:15 am – 4:30 pm
Itinerary : Hotung Secondary School (point of departure) → Lung Yeuk Tau Heritage Trail → Dining/Drinking experience of 'poon choi' (or 'big bowl feast') & steamed bun hands-on workshop → Sha Tau Kok Organic Farm → Hotung Secondary School (point of dismissal)
Fee : Free

All S2 students are required to participate in this activity. Those students who cannot take part in the segment of dining/drinking experience of 'poon choi' (or 'big bowl feast'), due to religious reasons or food allergy, etc., should prepare and bring along their own lunch. Students are advised to strictly comply with the instructions of both their teachers and the tour leader(s) to ensure safety. Re-scheduling arrangement will be announced at a later date.

**Contingency measures in case of bad weather
(outdoor activities)**

It is advisable to pay heed to announcements made on television or on the radio two hours before the scheduled activity is held and to take appropriate steps to ensure personal safety.

- (a) In case the Education Bureau announces the closure of all secondary schools, the scheduled activity is to be cancelled. Students should stay at home and not return to school to ensure personal safety.
- (b) In case the Hong Kong Observatory issues a red or black rainstorm warning signal, or in case it issues any tropical cyclone warning signal (i.e. No. 1 or above), the scheduled activity is to be cancelled as the bad weather condition makes it unsafe to engage in any outdoor activity and students should remain in a safe place.
- (c) In case the Hong Kong Observatory issues a thunderstorm warning or an amber rainstorm warning signal, the teacher(s) in charge will decide whether the scheduled activity is to be held after taking into consideration the actual situation.
